
angladesh imports a lot of cotton from India for its garment manufacturing industry in Dhaka. The cotton producing area of Guntur is very close to Krishnapatnam Port. Due to lack of a direct shipping service between India and

Chittagong / Pangaon, a lot of cotton is moving through the Benapole border which is time consuming and costly. The river sea vessel service can greatly benefit the cotton exporters of India and the garment exporters of Dhaka with faster transit time and lower cost.

As the trade between India and Bangladesh is skewed, there is plenty of export from India, but very low level of import from Bangladesh to India to provide the vessel operators with a return load.

The solution is to permit transshipment containers of third countries for carriage on the vessels operating under the Coastal Shipping Agreement (vessels below 6000 GRT) for transshipment at Krishnapatnam so that the river sea vessels have return cargo. The Govt of Bangladesh deputed a high level delegation to visit India to study the suitability of ports to handle the transhipment of Bangladesh's 3rd country exim containers. NCT is already the largest transshipment terminal on the east coast of India, handling about 28,000 TEUs of

transshipment volume every month with a good network of transshipment feeder operators offering 5 sailings per week to upper Bay of Bengal ports.
